

Common Perceptions

- Too complicated & difficult to understand
- Requires too many leaders, too many classrooms, etc.
- Requires a lot of leader prep time each week
- Expensive awards, uniforms, gear, etc.
- Inflexible advancement schedules
- Requires a lot of record keeping & administration

Churches commonly seek ministries that are...

- Simple & easy to administer
- Require limited resources money, volunteers, facilities
- Minimal weekly prep time
- Flexible & customizable suitable for churches of any size or style
- Not dependent on a kid's regular attendance






What's NEW

- Simplified / streamlined meeting format
- Limited advancement (or none at all)
- Reduced cost & resources
- Easier leader prep

What's UN-CHANGED

- Gender-specific mentoring
- Guy-focus discipleship process
- Variety of activities to appeal to every boy
- Connected to the "community" of Royal Rangers



A Closer Look

The simplest form



The simplest form of "RR Lite"

- 1. All boys together in one group
- 2. All boys work on the same materials together
- 3. Teach "skills & activities" but not actual RR merits
- 4. No awards are presented
- 5. Uniform: T-shirts & jeans
- 6. Meetings: Opening, Bible Lesson, Skill Activity, Recreation



"Step-Up" Options

1 RR Lite	2 RR Lite Plus	3 RR Limited	4 RR Full Program
All boys in one group	Multiple groups of mixed ages	RK/DR & AR/ER groups	Separate groups
All boys work on same material	Each group works on a different skill, boys choose their group	Groups work on actual merits relevant to their group	Each group follows a unique advancement trail
Teach "skills & activities"	Teach "skills & activities"	Teach actual RR merits	Teach actual RR merits
No awards of any kind	Create your own award certificates, pins, etc.*	Present RR merits (but not advancement steps)	Merits & advancement steps

Advantages & Disadvantages

PROS:

- Simple & easy
- Lower cost, fewer resources
- Minimal prep time
- Maximum flexibility

CONS:

- No advancement steps (no GMAs)
- Limited junior leader development process
- Content is less age-specific

 programs who need a
 more suitable solution



Key Points to Remember

- Royal Rangers Lite is NOT a new program. It's merely an easier, simpler way of doing Royal Rangers, for churches who need or prefer one.
- Royal Rangers Lite IS Royal Rangers. Churches who choose conduct their program in this manner should still be considered to be official Royal Rangers groups.
